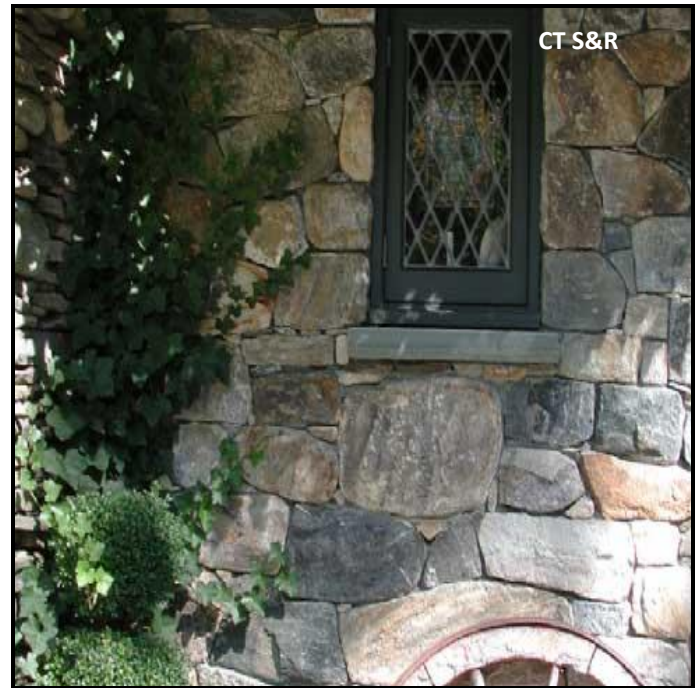




Connecticut Fieldstone

Product and Description



Description

Connecticut Fieldstone is a weathered granite ranging in color from subtle light to dark gray, browns and rust. Connecticut Fieldstone gives the appearance of the old New England stone walls that are native to the area.

Standard Sizes

- ◆ **Full Veneer:** Available in mosaic, and round patterns. The full thickness veneer is approximately 3.5" to 8" thick.
- ◆ **Thin Veneer:** Available in mosaic, ashlar, and round patterns, .75" to 1.5" thick.
- ◆ **Wall Stone:** Natural face fieldstone in a wide range of sizes suitable for making walls. Not suitable for low or narrow walls.
- ◆ **Irregular Flagging:** Roughly 1.5" to 4" in thickness with a wide range of sizes and a relatively flat surface for walking on.

Approximate Coverage

- ◆ **Full Veneer:** 30 to 35 square feet per cubic yard (± 26 to 30 square feet per ton).
- ◆ **Thin Veneer:** 14 lbs. per square foot.
- ◆ **Wall Stone :** 20 cubic feet per yard.
- ◆ **Irregular Flagging:** 65 square feet per ton.

Selling Unit

The veneer and wall stone are sold by the cubic yard. We can sell this stone by the weight when it is selected, but a maximum of one ton may be selected at a time. The flagging is sold by weight. The thin veneer is sold by weight or 50 square foot pallets.
