Description

Stafford Flagging is a natural cleft quartzite with warm silver grey tones, gold and rust. Mica and small garnet flecks add character to this natural flagging.

Standard Sizes

Irregularly shaped stones are 2" to 4" thick and approximately 18" x 18" up to 42" in one dimension.

Coverage

Coverage is approximately 50 to 60 square feet per ton depending on the joint width and stone thickness.

Selling Unit

Stafford Flagging is sold by weight. There is one ton per pallet. Stones may also be purchased from an open pallet individually. Only one pallet will be opened at any given time.

Application

Stafford Flagging is ideal for casual walkways, paths, pools or patios. It can simply be set in stone dust or concrete sand due to its thickness.

Availability

Stafford Flagging is generally stocked in large quantity and readily available.
